

Information for the O.L.G.C 2019 Swimming Carnival

The 2019 O.L.G.C Swimming Carnival for Years 2-6 will be held on Friday, February 22nd. This carnival aims to promote participation in a school community event whether your child is swimming or just supporting their peers. The carnival will begin at 9:30am and conclude at 2pm.

Permission notes have been sent home this week. **Please return the permission notes** to your child's teacher before Wednesday the 13th of February so that buses can be booked asap.

Booking events for your child

All event entries need to be booked online <https://www.schoolinterviews.com.au/> . Children will compete in races according to their year of birth. They may choose to compete in the following events:

<u>Freestyle-</u> 25m OR 50m*	<u>Butterfly-</u> 50m*
<u>Backstroke –</u> 25m OR 50m*	<u>Breaststroke-</u> 50m*

PLEASE NOTE: Selection for the OLGC Swimming Team will be made from events marked with a star

Children will not be able to swim on the day if they have not been booked into races. Bookings close Wednesday 13th of February at 3pm.

For all Volunteers

Thank you to all parents who are able to volunteer. Please select a job for the day, at www.schoolinterviews.com.au –Event code **pjxfk**. If you have volunteered as a helper you are able to transport your own children to the carnival on the day. Please arrive by 9:10am for instructions regarding your role. Please take note of the new parking arrangements to avoid fines in the carpark.

What to wear - All clothing must be clearly labelled with your child's name.

- Swimming costume – to be already on under their sport uniform as there will be no time to change.
- Sport shoes and socks (for safety reasons).
- A t-shirt that represents their colour house.
- School sports shorts

No coloured streamers, coloured zinc or hairspray are permitted at the carnival as enforced by Warringah Aquatic Centre.

What to pack

- Back pack with drinks, morning tea and lunch (**students will not have any access to the canteen at the venue**).
- Swimming cap and goggles (if swimming).
- Towel.
- Reading book or notepad and pencils for in between races.

Travelling to the carnival

All children are expected to catch the bus with their teacher to the carnival, unless you are an allocated parent helper. Buses will leave promptly at 9am so please be at school when the bell rings at 8:55am. There are no races starting before the buses are due to arrive.

Where to sit

Parents will be asked to view the carnival from the stands on the entrance side of the pool in the clearly labelled *Spectators Stand*. Only volunteers with allocated jobs will have access to pool side areas and the *Children Stands* where the children sit supervised by teachers.

Children must stay in their age group area supervised by the teachers in the Children Stands at all times unless going to the toilet or competing in a race.

What times are the races?

The carnival begins at 9:30am. The Order of Events is attached. We unfortunately are unable to provide times for each event as it is not possible to determine how long each race will take.

When will the carnival end?

The carnival has been booked until 2pm. **Children will be allowed to leave the pool with their parents after 1:30pm.** If you are taking your child home from the swimming pool, please report to your child's classroom teacher and have their name marked off before taking your child. No child will be allowed to go home with **another parent**, unless it has been arranged earlier in writing with their class teacher.

Parking

New parking restrictions are now in affect at Warringah Aquatic Centre. The whole parking area has a 3 hour parking limit. All parents and volunteers will have to drive their cars out of the parking lot and drive back in to park somewhere different (inside the parking area).

Pool staff will announce reminders over the speakers throughout the duration of the carnival.
