ENGLISH

Writing & Representing:

This term the students will be engaged in writing factual and persuasive texts. They will write about a range of topics connected to our Environment Inquiry Unit. This term our class shall have a strong focus on using ipads to complete a range of research and publishing tasks, using a range of programs and apps. We shall continue to focus on blends, syllables and rhyming patterns when exploring a range of spelling and decoding strategies when reading and writing new or challenging words.

Reading and Viewing:

This term we shall be focusing on reading with fluency and expression and the children will be encouraged to explore the comprehension of both the literal and inferred meanings within a range of written and digital texts.

Speaking and Listening:

Students will present formal speeches as part of our annual Public Speaking Competition (Wk7 Talk time Roster) and will be involved in a range of speaking and listening opportunities when sharing opinions and researched information in both small and large group settings.

MATHEMATICS

Number & Algebra: Fractions and Decimals, Addition and subtraction Multiplication and Division, Patterns and Algebra.

Measurement & Geometry: Area, 3D Space, Mass, Volume and Capacity, Position. **Statistics & Probability:** Chance.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT/HEALTH

This term we are exploring a unit of work called 'I can do it!'. In this unit of work the children will identify the qualities and strength required to develop resilience and determination through exploring a range of stories about individuals and groups who have overcome challenges.

INTEGRATED INQUIRY: How do different wet environments support a variety of fauna and flora? (Australian perspective)
