

# Year 3 2021 Term 2 Overview

## **Mathematics**

Some of the key ideas we will be focusing on throughout term are:

- Addition and subtraction using mental strategies up to four digit numbers.
- Multiplication facts for 2,3,4,5,10
- Commonly used fractions
- Measuring and comparing areas
- 2D and 3D shapes and their properties
- Identify in angles of various sizes
- Chance: Identify and describe possible 'outcomes' of chance experiments.
- Volume and Capacity: Use litres to measure, compare and estimate capacities and volumes
- Position: Use grid-referenced maps to locate and describe positions and pathways
- Mass: Use kilograms to measure, compare, order and estimate masses.
