Year 3 2023 Term 3 Overview

Mathematics

Some of the key ideas the students will be focusing on throughout term are:

- Whole Number: Explore place value, read, write, and order numbers.
- Patterns and Algebra: Identify, continue, and create patterns.
- Addition and Subtraction: Use various mental strategies when answering a range of four-digit number questions.
- **Multiplication and Division:** Increase speed and accuracy, when recalling multiplication and division number facts, for 2, 3, 4, 5 and 10.
- Fractions: Identify and explore the features of halves, thirds, quarters, fifths, and eighths of one whole, or a group.
- Area: Measure various shapes and places using square metres and centimetres.
- **3D Space:** Explore a range of shapes and their properties.
- Angles: Identify and measure angles of various sizes.
- Position: Use grid-referenced maps to locate and describe positions and pathways.
- Mass: Use kilograms and grams to measure, compare, order, and estimate masses.
- **Data:** Collect, organise, display, and interpret data.

English

Speaking & Listening

Public Speaking: Compose and present a speech.

Reading & Viewing

- Shared Reading: Read and respond to a range of multimodal texts, including "Are we there yet?" "Thai-riffic!" and "The Little Refugee."
- Instructional Reading Groups: Read with fluency and expression, while exploring a range of comprehension skills and strategies.
- Independent Reading: Read texts from the class and school libraries.

Spelling

- Study high frequency words / theme words / word families / rhyming words and review and consolidate consonant blends and vowel diagraphs.
- Proofread and edit for spelling errors in personal writing.

Writing

- Write a variety of texts focusing on structure, audience, and purpose.
- Check and improve punctuation, paragraphing, grammar, and vocabulary through careful editing and proofreading.

Handwriting & Digital Technologies

- Focus on correct pencil grip and posture, letter size and formation.
- Explore various Apps and teacher selected websites to enhance learning across all KLAs.
- Touch Typing web based activities.

Religion

Prayer and Sacraments

The students will:

- Explore and experience various aspects of the sacramental, spiritual, and liturgical life of the Catholic Church.
- Learn about personal and communal prayers and traditional forms of Catholic prayer.
- Learn about sacramental life and how it is designed to support and complement the parish sacramental programs.
- · Learn about the Sacrament of Confirmation.
